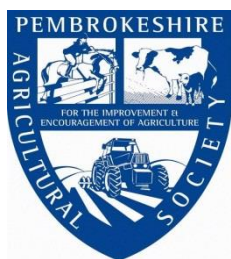

PRESIDENT'S AWARD

*The President, Brian Harries Esq. will present his award
to a person or persons who has given long standing voluntary support to the Society

Student Bursary

The Bursary award is open to all qualifying students studying agriculture, veterinary science, agricultural engineering, food technology, forestry or other subjects clearly allied to agriculture. The £1000 is tax free and will be awarded to the student who, in the opinion of a panel of judges, has submitted the best Dissertation on how the Bursary will assist them to complete their course of study.

A panel of independent judges chaired by a representative of the Society will draw up a short list of candidates who will be interviewed. The winning candidate will be asked to give a short presentation at a future meeting of the Society's Show Council.

2. Failure to complete the course will result in cancellation of the award and where appropriate re-imburement of monies received.

GENERAL

ALL CATTLE, SHEEP, PIG & GOAT EXHIBITORS must comply with the Showground Bio-Security Regulations, Welfare Plan and Animal Gatherings Order 2011.

1. DATE & LOCATION OF SHOW

The Show will be held on 14th – 16th August 2018 at the County Showground, Withybush, Haverfordwest, Pembrokeshire, SA62 4BW.

2. PUBLIC PRICE OF ADMISSION

Gate prices: Adult £19.00; Senior £17.00; Junior £8.00; Super Saver £20.00 Family Saver £39.00. Please see www.pembsshow.org for ticket offers.

3. SOCIETY MEMBERSHIP

Details of membership for the Society are available from the website www.pembsshow.org.

4. EXHIBITOR ACCOMMODATION

Caravan passes for the Exhibitors Caravan Park can be purchased at the time of entry at a rate of £54.00 (inc VAT). N.B. Electric hook ups are not available. Shower and toilet facilities are located within the Caravan Park, outside the Livestock Building and in the Horse Parking Area.

5. STOCKMAN'S CATERING

The Stockmans Café will offer a dining facility for all exhibitors for Breakfast, Lunch & Supper and will be open from 7.00am to 9.00pm

6. ENTRY FEES

All entries for the Society's Shows shall be made upon the Society's Official Entry Form. It shall be deposited with the Show Organiser **not later than the closing date for entries** as specified in the Show Schedule and shall, in every case, be accompanied by the full amount of the appropriate entry fees.

Every Exhibitor shall sign the Declaration printed on the Entry Form:

"I/We hereby agree that the particulars stated are correct to the best of my knowledge and belief and I/We agree to conform to the rules and regulations for the Society which are laid out in the Schedule. I/We confirm I/We have my/our own Public Liability insurance."

Entries can be made by **POST** using the entry form provided in the schedule or downloadable from the website or **ONLINE** at www.pembsshow.org. All entry fees are inclusive of 20% VAT. Payment is accepted via credit/debit card or by cheque made payable to PAS. Fully paid Adult Members of the Pembrokeshire Agricultural Society are eligible for half price entry fees. **** Junior Members do not qualify for reduced entry fees**** All classes are subject to the entry fees outlined in the tables below, unless otherwise stated.

CLOSING DATE FOR POSTAL ENTRIES IS MONDAY, 2nd JULY & ONLINE ENTRIES IS MONDAY, 9th JULY LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

7. CANCELLATION OF CLASSES and/or ENTRIES

The Pembrokeshire Agricultural Society reserves the right to refuse any entry and cancel or amalgamate class or section if it deems fit. Exhibitors already entered will be offered entry into an alternative section where appropriate or the entry fee may be returned to each exhibitor after the show on the 14th – 16th August.

8. ANIMALS FOR SALE

If you wish any exhibit to be advertised as '**FOR SALE**' in the show catalogue, please indicate this on the entry form.

9. SUBSTITUTION

Except in the case of Show Jumping classes, no substitution or entries will be permitted on any section of the Show after the closing date of entries.

10. PRIZE MONEY

Prize money vouchers will be issued by the stewards at the same time the rosettes are awarded. The Prize Money vouchers can be redeemed for the relevant prize money at the Prize Money Office located opposite the President's Pavilion on Main Avenue during the Show Period. The Prize Money Office opening hours are 10.30am – 5.30pm each day. Any prize money **NOT** collected from the Prize Money Office during the Show Period will be issued via cheque only from the Show Office on receipt of the Prize Money Vouchers (*not Prize Cards*) by 30 September 2018.

11. AWARDS & PRESENTATIONS

In every livestock & equine class, five prizes shall be offered, but it shall be lawful for the Committee to add further prizes as they may from time to time deem desirable, and to relate the award of such additional prizes to the number of entries as they think fit. The prize may be withheld if, in the opinion of the Judge or Judges, the exhibit is unworthy or of insufficient merit.

Rosettes are awarded to 5th place in each class; other awards are coded as below and noted in each section where appropriate.

SC *Special class (no entry fee or prize money)*

SR *Special rosette*

SA *Special award*

ST *Special trophy*

SQ *Qualifier*

12. WRISTBANDS & VEHICLE PASS ENTITLEMENT

All exhibitors are issued with wristbands and vehicle passes based on the number of animals entered and days attending the show. This is set out in the information specific to each section. Additional wristbands can be purchased at the time of entry at the following rates: *Exhibitor wristbands £17.00 per wristband per day (inc. VAT); Livestock Vehicle pass £32.00 (inc VAT)*. Exhibitors are requested to check all tickets and passes on receipt. Only vehicles carrying livestock or horses and clearly displaying the relevant vehicle pass on the windscreen will be admitted at the relevant gates. Any person entering the site on Show days including the drivers of stock lorries, horseboxes or trailers must have a valid admission ticket or wristband or they will be expected to pay the full admission price at the gate. ***The Show will not take any responsibility for any tickets or passes that have been mislaid or forgotten.***

13. STEWARDS

No Steward or other official of the Show, whilst in charge of any animal competing in the Show, shall wear any rosette or ribbon when he enters the Judging Ring.

14. DRESS CODE

All exhibitors/handlers should ensure they are wearing the correct show clothing and footwear required to enter the designated show rings and the Grand Parades.

15. PUBLIC LIABILITY

All exhibitors must have public/third party insurance.

16. HEALTH AND SAFETY

The Organisers of this show have taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the Organisers and all the Officials and Stewards. Please ensure that all animals are show trained and that all show equipment is in good condition.

It is the exhibitors' responsibility to provide livestock and equine attendants and equipment necessary to control their livestock and horses & ponies at all times whilst on the Showground.

17. ANIMAL WELFARE

The Pembrokeshire Agricultural Society is very keen to ensure the health and welfare of all livestock that attend the annual County Show and other events that the Society organises. Show organisers have an obligation (under the terms of the Animal Welfare Act 2006 Section 9 (2)) to ensure that the best welfare practices are observed at all times and this also assists in the prevention of the spread of animal diseases. This involves working to the regulations and guidelines set out by government organisations and developing policies and procedures that can be complied with by the Society's representatives i.e. staff and voluntary workers, exhibitors and the general public. The PAS Welfare Plan has been drawn up with the assistance of the show's appointed veterinary surgeons, Fenton Vets & Cotts Equine Hospital and demonstrates that due consideration has been given to all aspects of animal health and welfare at the show. The plan is available for inspection by the animal health authorities if required.
